Vote today to fund improvements in your community! Your Council Member has allocated at least \$1 million of their budget to fund projects in places like streets, parks, libraries, schools, and community centers — you decide how it is spent through participatory budgeting (PB)! **PB gives ordinary people real power over real money.**

You can vote in PBNYC 2017 if you:

- Live in a participating district and are at least 14 years old
- Volunteered as a budget delegate

Vote now!

Ask for a paper ballot in your language or vote online at www.pbnyc.org/vote. You can vote for up to 5 projects!

How to vote online:

1. Visit www.pbnyc.org/vote
2. Select your **preferred language**.
3. Fill out the digital voter affidavit to confirm you can vote in PBNYC.
4. Select your Council District or type in your address to look it up.
5. Enter your cell phone number and receive a text message with a verification code (**standard messaging rates apply*).
6. Enter your verification code when prompted
7. Vote for up to 5 projects!
8. Please complete the optional survey or click "Skip and submit my vote now".
9. You're done! Enter your e-mail address if you'd like to receive updates and results.

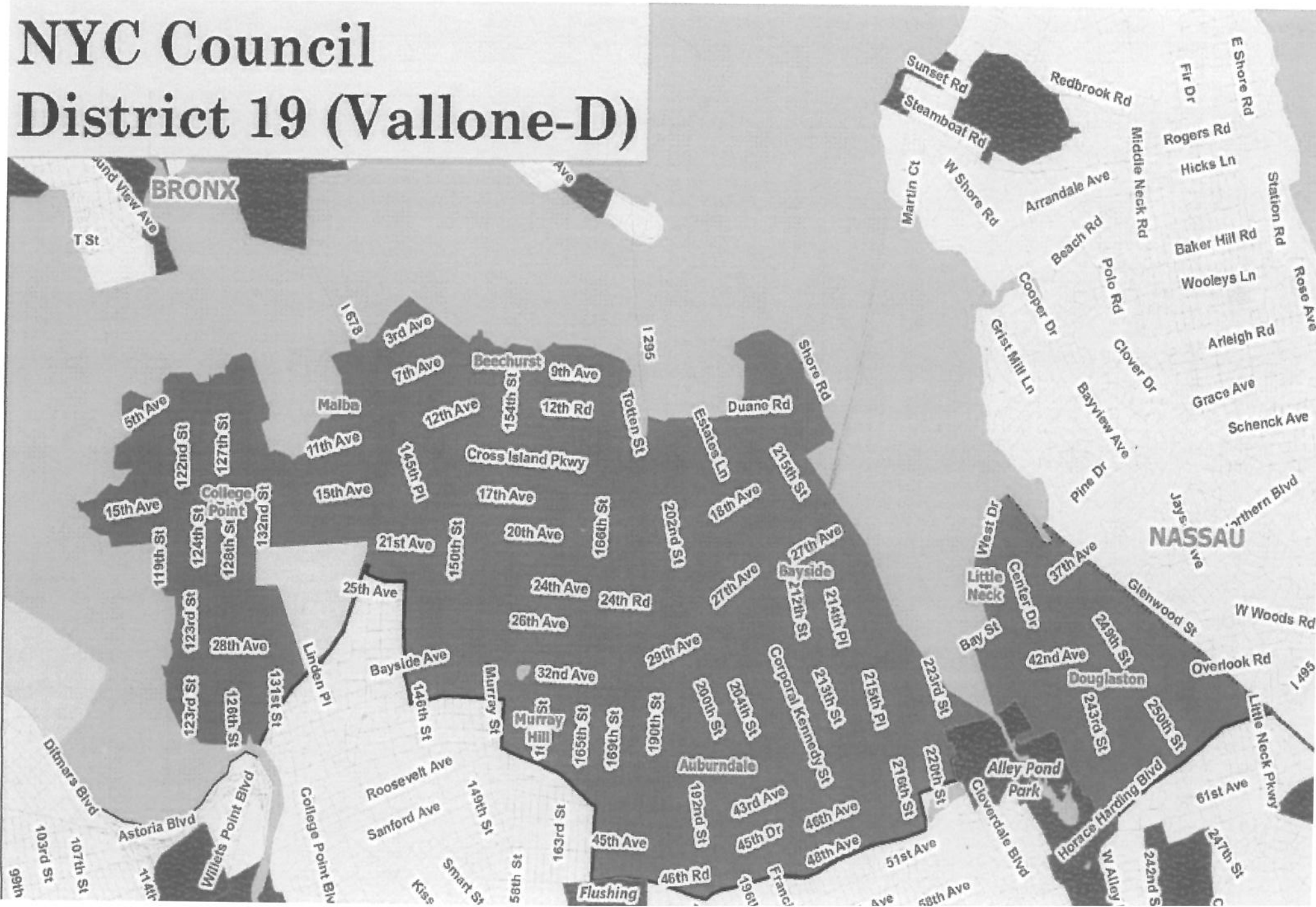

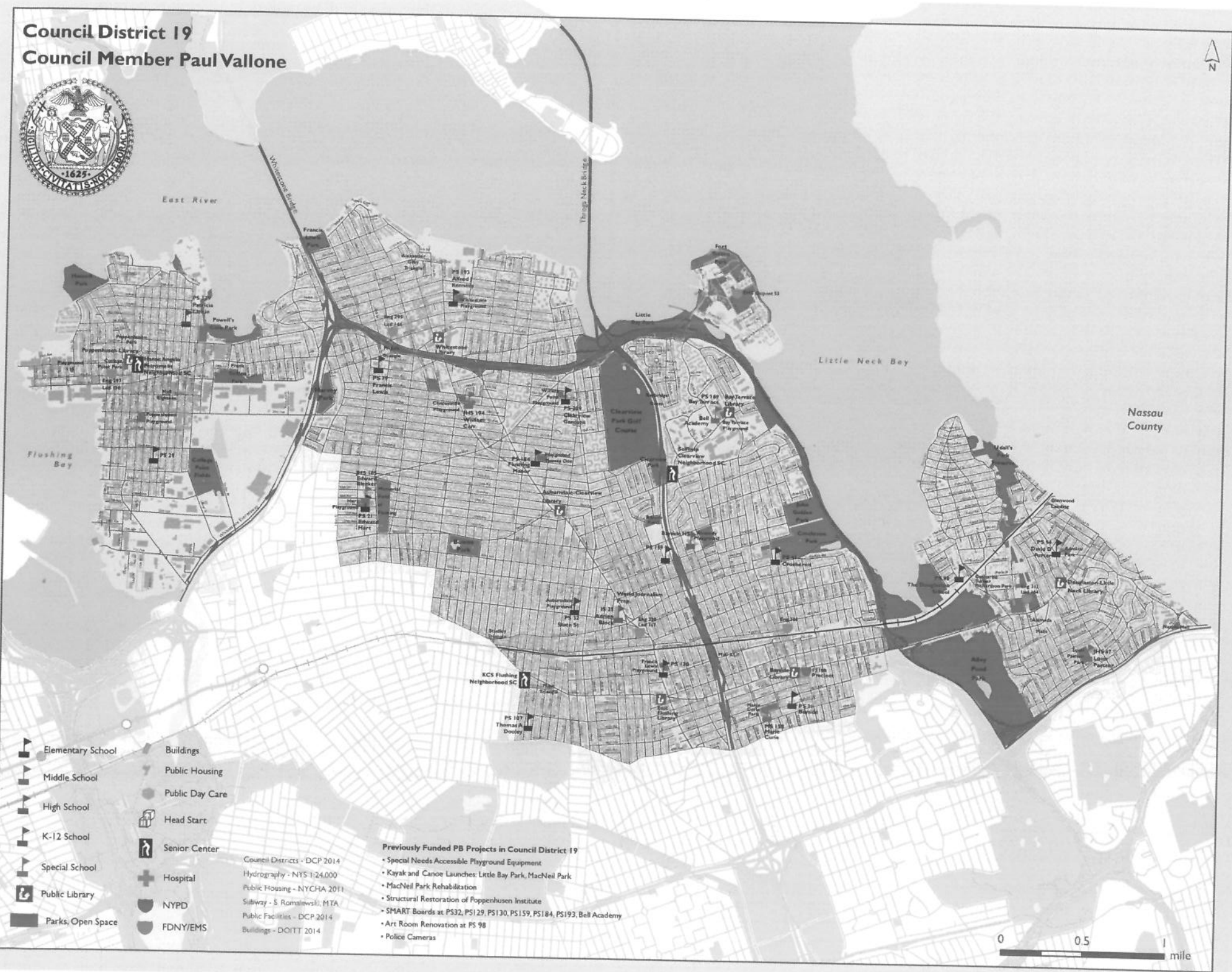
